2. To Receive Declarations of Interest and consider Applications for Dispensation: None.

3. Public Session:

- Outstanding investigation into employment issues with previous Clerk
- Outstanding household consultation regarding sport facilities
- Persistent excessive dog mess in the Village
- Perception of the existence of an inner Council and new Councillors being excluded
- Reminder to the Councillors of their duties under the Code of Conduct
- Heated debate about agenda item 5 and also agenda item 10 from the meeting held on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> August
