Minutes of Parish Council Meeting held on Monday 9th May 2016, 7.00pm at Upper Rissington Village Hall

- 1. Apologies: Cllr Brian Hanks, Cllr Dawn Laird
- 2. To Receive Declarations of Interest and consider Applications for Dispensation: None.
- **3. Public Session:** The following points were made during the public session:
 - Would the Parish Council consider the frequency of the hedgerow cutting as a future agenda item i.e. annually or every other year
 - Progress was queried with amendments to lease to Village Hall Trust
 - Update on land owned by the Parish Council as it was noted a new issue has been highlighted in respect of the footpath off Bristol Road and Lincoln Close

DA joined the meeting at this juncture.

- **4. Minutes:** The minutes of the Parish Council Meetings held on Monday 4th April and Wednesday 20th April were approved by Council as a true record. The 4th April minutes were proposed by JC and seconded by AM. **Motion carried.** The 20th April minutes were proposed by JC and seconded by AM. **Motion carried.**
- **5.** Re-numbering of Minutes: To approve the re-numbering and re-signing of minutes from 12th October, 13th November and 23rd November 2015 due to a numbering error The re-numbering and re-signing of the minutes was approved by the Council. Proposed by CM and seconded by JC. **Motion carried.**
- **6. Purchase of Laptop:** *To consider and approve purchase of new laptop for the Clerk* The quotes for purchase of a new laptop were considered. It was agreed to purchase a new 15.6" laptop, laptop bag, mouse and Office 365 for a total amount not exceeding £500. Proposed by JC and seconded by CM. **Motion carried.**
- 7. Ratification of decisions made on 17th February:
 - (i) Planning Application: 16/00075/FUL for the conversion and change of use of the existing watch tower into a single dwelling at Rissington Airfield. It was decided that the PC would support the new application to convert the building into a residential dwelling but with the restriction that occupation of the property should only take place after the provision of 1,500 m² of B1 space.
 - (ii) Miniature Castle: The PC agreed to seek help from LB to protect the castle in the short term possibly in the form of a fence and a final decision on its location would be made during the open spaces discussions between LB and the PC.
 - (iii) Payments: Payments agreed as in Appendix 1 and vires from contingency/reserves authorised.
 - (iv) Tree Works: Authorisation deferred until further information provided
 The decisions were all ratified unanimously. Proposed by DA and seconded by JC. **Motion carried.**AM stated that he disagreed that this matter needed to be an agenda item. JC felt that the process should be clarified in URPC's Standing Orders to avoid future confusion.
